Gurukulam style learning from scholars like Sri Purasai Nadadur Krishnamachariar and Sri O. R. Rajagopalachariar Swamy, gave Swami the initial knowledge and

Over the years, Swami's delivery style of combining his Upanyasams with enjoyable anecdotes and current affairs, was imbibed from his close association with Sri Mukkur Lakshminarasimhachariar, Thirukallam Sri Narasimha Raghavachariar and Sri K. V. Santhanagoplachariar. Swami's M.A., M. Phil and Ph.D. in Sanskrit, raises his Upanyasams to new heights.

Seeing his zeal and enthusiasm in our Sampradhaya Srimad Azhagiya Singar Jeer of Ahobila Mutt appointed Swami as Editor of "Sri Narasimhapriya". The magazine underwent changes in style and presentation, resulting in broad-based audience interest, and increased circulation. Swami also writes religious articles for other magazines. Between 2013 and 2015 Swami went on a prolific book writing spree, and published over 15 books, on rare subjects like Sri Ahobhila Kshetra Mahatmiyam, and Bharatha Savithri. The well researched books, bring out Swami's deep understanding and knowledge, and are available in Tamil, Telugu, Sanskrit, Kannada and English.

To carry the message across the globe, Swami presented "Dinam oru Divya Namam" from Vishnu Sahasranamam, a daily capsule TV programme. Audience began to look forward to delightful virtual tours to ancient temples which was part of the programme. Swami's "Tapovanam" covering great Rishies, brought the risky to reach mountains, caves and forests in the comfort of our drawing rooms. The ongoing programme of "Nadhi Moolam" is not only a visual experience, but also reminds us of our cultural origins. "Sri Ramanuja Vaibhavam" on Podhigai reflects his quest for research and in-depth knowledge.

Smt. Anitha Guha, with God's gift of grace and elegance, natural talent for choreography, and passion to teach youngsters, founded Bharathanjali in 1989. Sri Rama Navami rasikas still recall her unique, appealing and inspiring "Koodiyirundhu Kulimdhelore Empaavai" of 2009.

Rated as the foremost ballet producer of her generation, Smt. Anitha in her inimitable style presents her creative interpretation of Sundara Kandam, with utmost devotional fervor and intensity, through 22 member strong dance drama. Chennai still recalls in glowing terms the Vaali-Sugreeva battle, for the quality of dancing and emoting. Hanuman crossing the sea, the poignant moment of presenting Rama's ring, Lanka on fire, Rama seeing the choodamani— the dramatic elements stand out, through a sensitive journey of rasa and bhava, supported by musical brilliance, and crisp choreography. Lyrics are penned by Sri Neyveli Santhanagopalan, and rendered by Ms. Sriranjani, Smt. Gayathri Venkataraghavan and Smt. Nisha Rajagopal.

Titles like Acharya Rathnakara, Madura Kalamani, Nritya Ratna, Acharya Kalabharathi, all sit lightly on the shoulders of Smt. Anitha, even while she humbly dedicates her works at the lotus feet of Sri Sathya Sai Baba.

### Selvi, Salem R. Rukmani

April 8-10

Selvi Rukmani, the fiery speaker we saw on Rama Navami stage, as a part of Sri. M. M. Ismail's Pattimanram team, in mid seventies. has only aged, but the fire power is intact. Selvi Rukmani recalls with nostalgia, Sri Rama Navami Secretary Sri Subasri's felicitation. "Idhuva petchu? Idhuthan petchu", on completion of two Tamil literary Ramayana lectures in 1980.

Selvi Rukmani, hails from Namakkal. She is a Tamil Vidhwan. Has four M.A degrees. In Tamil, History, Economics and Sociology. Prolific speaker. Travelled all



over the world. Has presented Bharatham over 500 times. Kamba Ramayanam over 320 times. Kandha Puranam over 110 times. Delves into religious waters of Bhagavatham, Thiruuppavai, Thiruvembavai, Thiruppugazh, Thiruvasagam, Ramanujar etc. Equally eloquent in literary subjects like Sanga Tamil, Thirukkural, Bharathi, Kannadhasan, Vivekanandar etc.

There are many legendary tales in Salem-Erode side. Once while Selvi Rukmani was presenting "Krishnan Thoodhu" in Erode, many in the crowd vouch to having seen a vision of Lord Krishna moving from one side of the stage to another, behind the speaker. A Christian boy burdened with his problems decided to end his life, chanced to hear her "Karnan". Moved by the narration, and the burden on Kama, decided to live, and did make a success of his life. And there is this family from Australia, whose hyperactive and challenged son, patiently heard Rukmani's Kanda Puranam on Youtube, and actually improved thereafter. Divinity has no boundaries.

Shri Swami hails from the noble Thirumalai Anandalwan lineage. Thirumalai Anandalwan was sishya of Sri Ramanujar, who did pushpa kainkaryamm in Thirumala, and is considered an amsam of Adhiseshan. Shri Swami is also the great grandson of Keerthi Moorthi Sri U. Ve. Pradhivadhi Bhayankaram Annangaracharya Swami of

Kancheepuram, who was a legendary figure on our Sampradaya. He is the grandson of Sri U. Ve. Mahavidwan Akkarakani T. A. Sampathkumaracharya Swami. Shri Swami considers it his "bhagyam" to be bom in this parampara.

Discourses on stage from tender age of 7, Shri Swami considers U. Ve. Sri K. B. Devarajan Swami as his guru, from whom he absorbed the important, Sri Vaishnava Sampradaya Rahasiya Grandham and Srivachana Bhooshanam.

Presence of Thirumaligai sishyas in various parts of the country, has helped in travel widely. Interest in reading on a whole range of subjects. Cricket enthusiast. He has launched the Ramanuja Priya Trust. Primarily focuses on grama pracharam of our sampradaya. Plans to set up a library in Kancheepuram, with a wide range of books.
