2019 is the 125th year of birth of His Holiness, Paramacharya of Kanchi Kamakoti Peetam, Sri Sri Chandrasekharendra Saraswathi Mahaswamigal. Sri Rama Navami Cultural Festival, is delighted to present special commemorative programmes, as a part of the 58th festival celebrations.

Sixty-eighth in the hallowed line of succession from Adi Sankara- His Holiness was born as Swaminathan on May 20, 1894 and ascended the Kanchi Kamakoti Peetam on Feb 13, 1907. HH was a remarkable person. Deeply imbued in Sanskrit lore, especially the Shastras and the Vedanta. He is at the same time a scholar in several branches of learning like art, architecture, archaeology, politics, economics and inscriptions. He was a linguist who can speak many languages. Austere by himself and immersed in penance by fastings and vigils, puja and contemplation, his accessibility to all who go to him for guidance and advice, is well known. He is endowed with singular powers of memory and his exposition of abstract philosophical truths, are marked with facility of easy explanation.

Sri Subasri, the founder Secretary of Sri Rama Navami Cultural Festival, has drawn great inspiration from HH, in evolving the festival programmes. The honouring of Vedic Pundits every year, the weekly "pidi-arisi" annadhanam, the dash of folklore in the programme card, all reflect this.

April 6 to 8 we a have six lectures by six very eminent scholars, each presenting a widely different perspective of HH. The speech titles symbolically reflect a "pushpanjali" to HH. Four lectures are titled from "Chandrasekhara Saraswathi Ashtotra Sathanamavali". Sri Suki Sivam has selected from Vishnusahasranamam and Justice has taken a line from HH's own music composition.

For the first time we have great pleasure in presenting the renowned Brahmasri Chaganti Koteswara Rao garu on our stage. April 17 to 19, we have his pravachanam in Telugu on "Dharma Swaroopam - Paramacharya".

The third part of the commemorative programmes is the mammoth drama, "Dheivathul Dheivam", presenting the life history of Paramacharya on stage. In a first, we are repeating the drama on two days, so that more audience from the twin cities can enjoy/benefit.



Justice Sri V. Ramasubramanian of the High Court of Judicature Telangana in Hyderabad, is known for his wit, wisdom and scholarly treatment of complex legal issues. A student of Vivekananda college, after practicing Law, Sri Ramasubramanian was appointed as a Judge of Madras High Court in 2006. In 2016 he was moved to the High Court of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh. Unanimously revered by all members of the Legal fraternity. Innovative judge who even conducted a part of Division bench hearing over skype. His judgements portray a wave of deep empathy, reading the law

beyond letter, to effectuate justice and fairness.



It narrates the episode of Paarijaathapaharanam of Lord Krishna wherein the Lord uproots the celestial tree for the sake of His consort Sathyabhama. Sri Arvind Sitaraman is a Computer Scientist and was one of CISCO System's leading inventors with 57 patents to his name. He managed CISCO's R&D activities in India 2007-2009. He sponsored The Innovative Hub to incubate new technologies and create solutions to emerging countries. He led CISCO India's CSR efforts and launched successful programmes "Feed-a-child", "Adopta-School" etc. He took a lead in rehabilitation of tsunami victims in south India and flood relief works in Karnataka. He created a volunteer led programme to rehabilitate villages through technology and built 3323 homes, 1 hospital and 2 schools. Sri Arvind morphed this project into a

vehicle to deliver inclusive growth worldwide.

Sri Aravind promoted Sivagami Ammal Memorial Trust to promote Indian art and culture and serves on the advisory board of Akshaya Patra (feed poor children)and Nanobi (big data analytics). 
